## MAJOR COURSES

### Requirement A

A minimum of 11 credits in POLS 1000-level courses. It's recommended these courses be taken during the first two years.

### Requirement B

A minimum of 24 credits in POLS at the 2000-level or above from the following four areas (B1-4):

## RELATED COURSES

At least 12 credits in courses related to POLS taken from one or more other departments. These courses must be at the 2000-level or above. All 2000-level or above courses in ANTH, ECON, GEOG, HIST, HRTS, PHIL, PP, and SOCI will meet this requirement. Any course within these departments that is cross-listed with POLS will count towards the major and not as a related. Certain other courses have been approved as relateds and are listed on the [Department of Political Science's website](#). Courses not in the departments listed above or included on the pre-approved list may be approved as relateds at the discretion of the advisor.

## NOTES

- In order to fulfill requirements, all courses must be taken as graded (not P/F).
- A W or Q may be substituted for the same numbered course.
- POLS courses that are listed under multiple groups/subdivisions may only be used to fulfill one group/subdivision.
- All POLS 2995, 2998/W, and 3995 courses may apply to the concentration and may count towards Requirement B1. The groups/subdivisions assigned to these courses can be found on the [Department of Political Science website](#).
- No more than six credits of 3999: Independent Study, 4894: Colloquium, 2996/3996: Directed Research, and/or 3991: Supervised Field Work can be counted toward the 24 credits. Of those six, only three may be from 3991.
- POLS 3993, 3999, 4994, and 4997W may not be counted towards any requirement.
