- All POLS 2995, 2998/W, and 3995 courses may apply to the concentration and may count towards Requirement B1. The groups/subdivisions assigned to these courses can be found on the Department of Political Science website.
- No more than six credits of 3999: Independent Study, 4894: Colloquium, 2996/3996: Directed Research, and/or 3991: Supervised Field Work can be counted toward the 24 credits. Of those six, only three may be from 3991.
- POLS 3993, 3999, 4994, and 4997W may not be counted towards any requirement.
