Notes

- In order to fulfill requirements, all courses must be taken as graded (not P/F).
- A W or Q course may be substituted for the same numbered course.
- POLS courses that are listed under multiple subdivisions may only be used to fulfill one subdivision.
- POLS 2995, 2998/W, and 3995 sections apply to the minor and may count towards B1. The subdivisions that these sections are assigned to can be found on the [Department of Political Science's website](https://clas.uconn.edu/).
- POLS 2996, 3991, 3993, 3996, 3999, 4894, 4994, and 4997W may not be counted towards the minor.
- Completion of a minor requires that a student earn a C (2.0) grade or better in each of the required courses for that minor.
- Substitutions are not allowed. Transfer credits will only be counted if approved by the CLAS Academic Services Center.
